4TH ANNUAL LINCOLN PARK FITA

SATURDAY, AUGUST 21, 2010

The Chicago Bow Hunters JOAD Program is pleased to host its fourth annual Lincoln Park FITA. We are indebted to the Lincoln Park Archery Club for allowing us to once again use their marvelous facility on the lakefront. This year's tournament will be a sanctioned **"STAR FITA"** event. Shooting distances, target sizes, bow styles and age divisions will all comply with NAA guidelines.

Pre-registration and Tournament Fee: Registration is required in advance since the venue can only accommodate a total of forty archers. Registration can be completed online at www.chicagobowhunters.com. The deadline is August 16th to guarantee your spot on the shooting line. The tournament fee is \$30 (this will include a picnic lunch...see note below at *Accommodations*).

Schedule: Tournament check-in will be at 7:15 am. Practice will be from 8:00-8:45 am. Scoring will begin at 9:00 am. There will be a one hour break following the completion of the second distance. Please note: If weather factors do not allow for the tournament to take place, it will be held on Sunday, August 22nd.

Location: The Lincoln Park Archery Club is located at 3650 N. Lake Shore Drive in Chicago. From the south, exit Lake Shore Drive at Recreation Drive. Turn right, and proceed towards Belmont Harbor. From the north, exit at Irving Park Road. Take a quick left under the viaduct, and proceed south until you reach Belmont Harbor. Depending on your arrival time and the whims of the City of Chicago, you might have to pay a \$10 parking fee.

Accommodations: There will be a grill fired up during the break for lunch. For tournament participants, your registration fee will include a picnic lunch...brats, hot dogs, potato salad, chips, etc. Spectators are welcome to join in the picnic, but a \$5 donation is suggested. With the unique lakefront location and parking fee issues, it has been our past experience that it is best to eat lunch on site. Vegetarian or other dietary concerns...please bring your own. Restroom facilities are located across the street at Belmont Harbor. Also plan to bring shade canopies and lawn chairs.

Awards: Medals will be awarded for the first three placements in each division.
